

NOTIFICATION OF CLOSURE
Santee Cooper Winyah Generating Station
CCR Unit: Class 3 Landfill Area 1
(40 C.F.R. §257.102(f))

The Disposal of Coal Combustion Residuals (“CCR”) from Electric Utilities rule became effective on October 19, 2015. Pursuant to 40 C.F.R. §257.102(f)(3), the owner or operator of a CCR unit must obtain a certification from a qualified professional engineer verifying that closure has been completed in accordance with the closure plan specified in 40 C.F.R. §257.102(b) and the requirements of 40 C.F.R. §257.102. The above-referenced CCR unit was closed by leaving CCR in place pursuant to 40 C.F.R. §257.102(d). In accordance with 40 C.F.R. §257.102(h), Santee Cooper hereby provides notice that it has closed the Winyah Generating Station’s Class 3 Landfill Area 1, which ceased closure activities on July 24, 2024.
