

## Notice of Deed Notation Recording

### Winyah Generating Station, Class 3 Landfill Area 1

The South Carolina Public Service Authority (Santee Cooper) is implementing the April 17, 2015, U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) Federal Coal Combustion Residuals (CCR) Rule (40 CFR §257 and 261) for the Winyah Generating Station, located in Georgetown County, South Carolina.

Santee Cooper hereby provides notice of its recording of a deed notation as part of the closure of Winyah Generating Station's Class 3 Landfill Area 1. The Class 3 Landfill Area 1 is a CCR landfill that was closed by leaving the CCR material in place. In accordance with §257.102(i) and §257.107(i)(9), this Notice of Deed Notation Recording for Winyah Class 3 Landfill Area 1 was prepared for the Operating Record and public CCR website.

*§257.102(i)(1) Except as provided by paragraph (i)(4) of this section, following closure of a CCR unit, the owner or operator must record a notation on the deed to the property, or some other instrument that is normally examined during title search.*

A notation to the deed of Winyah Generating Station's Class 3 Landfill Area 1 was recorded with the Register of Deeds for the County of Georgetown, South Carolina on December 13, 2024.

*§257.102(i)(3) Within 30 days of recording a notation on the deed to the property, the owner or operator must prepare a notification stating that the notation has been recorded. The owner or operator has completed the notification when it has been placed in the facility's operating record as required by §257.105(i)(9).*

This Notice of Deed Notation Recording was placed in the Operating Record and on the public CCR website on December 16, 2024.
