(Journeyman)

Chief Judge: Kyle Powell

Mean Time: 14 Minutes

Drop Dead Time: 22 Minutes

Event Summary: Teams will climb a 40′ pole equipped with three eight-foot crossarms. The first crossarm will be mounted at 21.5′ and equipped with a drop in pin with a polymer insulator. The second crossarm will be mounted at 27.5′ and equipped with a polymer dead-end insulator attached to the arm with a 5/8″ eyebolt. The top crossarm will be mounted at 32.5′ and will be equipped with a 100-amp fused cut-out attached with an L bracket (the L bracket will be moved with the cutout). The handline will be hanging from an eyebolt in the back of top arm on the left side. Each team member including the groundman will be required to stop at each arm and relocate the equipment to the opposite end of the arm. Once all team members have relocated the equipment and the last climber has both feet on the ground and fall arrest belt removed from the pole time will stop.

Event Description:

- 1. Teams will be allowed a 5-minute setup time. The team may direct questions to the judge at this time.
- 2. Each climber may choose to start at the bottom arm or the top arm.
- 3. Time starts on the judge's signal with fall arrest belt detached from the pole.
- 4. All hardware must be properly tightening and installed.
- 5. All pins and cotter keys must face inward towards the pole.
- 6. All general rules apply.
