With only \$5million available, will the number of projects awarded be limited, i.e. only the top 200 projects will be awarded funds?

Answer

Santee Cooper anticipates that there could be a greater number of requests for funding than could be funded under the allocation. Should the overall number of requests exceed the available funds for Year Three, Santee Cooper will evaluate each proposal based on the metrics discussed in sections 2. Program Objects and 3: Community Benefits of the RFP.

Question

We are preparing an application for the next round and would like to know how much funding is available to municipalities? Is there a cap on the amount that can be requested, or a recommended range?

Answer

The available funding for FY24 is \$6,276,979. The only federal mandated set aside is for small utilities (eligible entities that sell not more than 4,000,000 megawatt hours of electricity per year) which for South Carolina would be no less than 30% of the available funding. There is no cap on the amount that can be requested or a recommended range.
